ORDINANCE NO. 1982

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 605.070 PERTAINING TO BUSINESS LICENSES FOR TATTOO AND BODY PIERCING ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, the current ordinance (Section 605.070) does not allow a tattoo and/or body piercing establishment within three hundred (300) feet of any school building, church building, school play yard, public playground or athletic facility.

WHEREAS, the current ordinance (Section 605.070) does not allow business license applicants for tattoo and/or body piercing establishments to request an exception for the location of the business from the Board of Aldermen.

WHEREAS, to allow the Board of Aldermen to make exceptions on a case by case basis, the new ordinance shall allow a tattoo and/or body piercing establishment to obtain written consent for the location of the establishment within the 300 feet of restricted buildings.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Valley Park, Missouri desires to amend Section 605.070 pertaining to the business licenses of tattoo/body piercing establishments and their location within the City of Valley Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF VALLEY PARK, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One

Section 605.070 pertaining to business licenses for tattoo and body piercing establishments is hereby amended as follows:

In addition to any requirements imposed by Section 621.010, et seq., of the St. Louis County Code of Ordinances, no permit shall be issued permitting the operation of any tattoo and/or body piercing establishment within three hundred (300) feet of any school building, church building, school play yard, public playground or athletic facility thereof, the distance to be measured in a straight line from the nearest point of the applicant to the nearest point of the school property line, **unless the applicant for the license shall first obtain the consent in writing of the Board of Aldermen. Such consent shall not be granted until at least ten (10) days' written notice has been provided to all owners of property within three hundred (300) feet of the proposed licensed premises.**

Section Two

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
