Absent:	Braswell, Reynolds

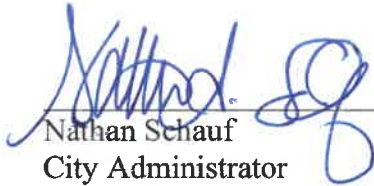
There was discussion about the number of votes needed to pass the ordinance and how to move forward to get a budget approved.
