NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Webster stated that comments made during the Special Board of Aldermen meeting from June 29th indicated Bill No. 2023-07 adopting the FY23/24 budget, Bill No. 2023-08 adopting the FY23/24 pay ranges, and Bill No. 2023-09 reaffirming the gross receipts tax had passed. This was incorrect and these bills had not passed.

Discussion was held regarding ensuring the minutes from the Special Board of Aldermen meeting held on June 29th indicated the bills did not pass.

Bill No. 2023-10 – Adopting FY23/24 Budget

Alderman Young expressed concerns that if the budget is not passed by July 4th, employees will not get paid. There was discussion on this matter.


ADJOURNMENT
