Shall the City of Valley Park impose a sales tax of three percent (3.0%) on the sale of adult use marijuana within the City of Valley Park to provide funding for the City's police department, infrastructure, and other City needs?

- This is <u>NOT</u> a vote to legalize recreational marijuana. Missouri voters approved a constitutional amendment in November 2022 allowing sales of recreational marijuana at licensed facilities.

- Proposition M is estimated to generate between \$50,000 and \$150,000 per year.
- If approved, the tax would help maintain vital City services including policing, street repair, and snow removal.
